



He is a full rank professor (Math Edu) that serves as Interim Chair of the Health, Physical and Secondary Education Department at Fayetteville State University and Chair of the Elizabeth City State University Foundation, he is responsible for a full range of administrative leadership, coaching, training, and consulting activities.

Being committed to community and social issues such as ADHD, anti-racism, gentrification and affordable housing, Dr. Lou serves the mathematics community as a leading equity and racial justice advocate, speaker and scholar.

Dr. Natasha T.K. Murray is an expert practitioner, teacher educator, administrator, professor, researcher, and consultant in K-12 and higher education settings; through her various roles within the field of education, she has developed, established, and expanded programs and initiatives that build and expand educational opportunities for all students.
